AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to reducing the number of hours in a work week to thirty-two for employers with at least five hundred employees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 160-a to 2 read as follows:
- § 160-a. Hours to constitute a week's work. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a legal week's work shall consist of thirty-two hours for any employer with at least five hundred employees who are not part of a collective bargaining agreement.
- 7 <u>2. No employee compensation shall be reduced due to the reduction in</u> 8 <u>hours considered a legal week's work under this section.</u>
- 9 3. This section shall not prevent an agreement for overwork at an increased compensation of at least one hundred fifty percent of the employee's base compensation.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2024.
