AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the incineration of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances as a means of disposal

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 37-0101 of the environmental conservation law is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 7 to read as follows:
- 7. "Perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances" or "PFAS" shall 4 mean substances that include any member of the class of fluorinated 5 organic chemicals containing at least one fully flourished carbon atom.
- § 2. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new 7 section 37-0121 to read as follows:
- § 37-0121. Prohibition against the incineration of perfluoroalkyl and 8 polyfluoroalkyl substances.
- 10 No person or entity shall incinerate, or cause to be incinerated, any 11 perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances.
- 12 § 3. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 13 have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or
- 14 repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of
- 15 this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and completed
- 16 on or before such effective date.
