AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to prohibiting the public service commission from interfering with the provisions of collective bargaining agreements relating to make-ready work entered into between certain utility companies and employees thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 119-a of the public service law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

5. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of this section, this article, this chapter, or any other contrary provision of law, nothing in
this section shall be construed to authorize the public service commission to interfere in any manner with provisions of a collective bargaining agreement relating to make-ready work entered into between a utility
company, utility corporation, telephone company or telephone corporation, cable television company or cable television corporation, or any
other entity subject to the provisions of this chapter and the employees
of any such entity.

2 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
