AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to protecting collective bargaining agreements between public service companies and their employees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 119-a of the public service law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
- 5. Nothing in this section shall be construed to authorize the public service commission to interfere in any manner with provisions of collective bargaining agreements relating to pole attachment work between a utility corporation, telephone corporation, cable television corporation or any entity subject to article eleven of this chapter and its employees.
  - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
