AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to expanding
the residential parking system in the village of Pelham in the county
of Westchester

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraphs (c) and (h) of subdivision 2 of section 1640-d
2 of the vehicle and traffic law, paragraph (c) as amended and paragraph
3 (h) as added by chapter 636 of the laws of 2006, are amended and seven
4 new paragraphs (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (n) and (o) are added to read as
5 follows:

6 (c) [~~the west side~~] both sides of Fifth Avenue, from [~~Seventh~~] Sixth
7 Street to Willow Avenue;

8 (h) both sides of Boulevard, from Wolfs Lane to Highbrook Avenue[~~-~~];

9 (i) both sides of Seventh Street, from the west end of Seventh Street
10 (dead end) to Sixth Avenue;

11 (j) both sides of Fourth Avenue, from Seventh Street to the dead end;

12 (k) both sides of Harmon Avenue, from Fifth Avenue to Harmon Place;

13 (l) the north side of First Street, from Wolfs Lane to Corlies Avenue;

14 (m) the west side of NYAC Avenue, two hundred feet south of the inter-
15 section with First Street to East Second Street;

16 (n) the east side of Fourth Avenue, from First Street to Second
17 Street;

18 (o) the west side of First Avenue, from First Street to Third Street.

19 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
20 have become a law.
