AN ACT to amend the village law and the public officers law, in relation to qualifications to hold certain positions in the village of Scarsdale

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 32 to read as follows:

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32. Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter or any other chap-4 ter, general law, local law, ordinance, or special act, the village board of trustees of the village of Scarsdale, Westchester county, may, by resolution, provide that the office of court clerk, building inspector, assistant building inspector, village clerk, assistant village clerk, village treasurer, assistant village treasurer, assessor, village 9 engineer, or village planner of such village may be held by a person who 10 is not a resident of such village, provided that such person resides within Westchester county or an adjoining county within the state of New 11 York, except that the village treasurer may also reside within Dutchess county. 13

14 § 2. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new 15 subdivision 72 to read as follows:

72. In the village of Scarsdale, Westchester county, the provisions of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are required to 20 be exercised, shall not prevent a person from holding the office of 21 court clerk, building inspector, assistant building inspector, village clerk, assistant village clerk, village treasurer, assistant village 23 treasurer, assessor, village engineer, or village planner, provided that 24 <u>such person resides within Westchester county or an adjoining county</u> within the state of New York, except that the village treasurer may also

- 2 ing the functions of such appointed positions in any other municipality
