AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to certain commercial food fish licenses, commercial crab permits, commercial whelk or conch licenses, marine and coastal district party and charter boat licenses and certain temporary authorizations for certain licenses and permits

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph c of subdivision 1, subpara-1 graph (i) of paragraph c of subdivision 3, subparagraph (i) of paragraph 2 3 c of subdivision 4 and subparagraph (i) of paragraph c of subdivision 5 4 of section 13-0328 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by 5 chapter 656 of the laws of 2021, are amended and a new subdivision 8 is б added to read as follows: (i) [licenses shall be issued in the order in which the applications 7 were received, except that where multiple applications are received by 8 9 the department on the same day, where the total number of commercial 10 food fish license applications from persons who were not issued such license in the previous year exceeds the number of licenses that are 11 12 available, the department shall randomly select recipients of the avail-13 able licenses from among those applications received by the first busi-14 ness day of the applicable license year, provided however that appli-15 cants shall receive one extra entry for each previous year that they applied for such license and were not selected, and applicants for whom 16 the department has received notice of successful completion of an 17 apprenticeship pursuant to subdivision seven of this section shall [be 18 considered by the department prior to other applicants] receive one 19 20 extra entry, and provided further that the department is authorized to 21 adopt regulations to amend or supplement this process for issuing 22 <u>commercial food fish licenses;</u> 23 (i) [permits shall be issued in the order in which the applications 24 were received, except that where multiple applications are received by 25 the department on the same day, where the total number of commercial

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crab permit applications from persons who were not issued such permit in 1 the previous year exceeds the number of permits that are available, the 2 department shall randomly select recipients of the available permits 3 4 from among those applications received by the first business day of the 5 applicable permit year, provided however that applicants shall receive 6 one extra entry for each previous year that they applied for such permit 7 and were not selected, and applicants for whom the department has received notice of successful completion of an apprenticeship pursuant 8 9 to subdivision seven of this section shall [be considered by the depart-10 ment prior to other applicants ] receive one extra entry, and provided further that the department is authorized to adopt regulations to amend 11 12 or supplement this process for issuing commercial crab permits; (i) [licenses shall be issued in the order in which the applications 13 14 were received, except that where multiple applications are received by 15 the department on the same day, ] where the total number of commercial whelk or conch license applications from persons who were not issued 16 17 such license in the previous year exceeds the number of licenses that are available, the department shall randomly select recipients of the 18 available licenses from among those applications received by the first 19 business day of the applicable license year, provided however that 20 21 applicants shall receive one extra entry for each previous year that 22 they applied for such license and were not selected, and applicants for 23 whom the department has received notice of successful completion of an 24 apprenticeship pursuant to subdivision seven of this section shall [be 25 considered by the department prior to other applicants] receive one extra entry, and provided further that the department is authorized to 26 27 adopt regulations to amend or supplement this process for issuing 28 commercial whelk or conch licenses; 29 (i) [licenses shall be issued in the order in which the applications were received] where the total number of marine and coastal district 30 31 party and charter boat license applications from persons who were not 32 issued such license in the previous year exceeds the number of licenses 33 that are available, the department shall randomly select recipients of 34 the available licenses from among those applications received by the first business day of the applicable license year, provided however that 35 36 applicants shall receive one extra entry for each previous year that 37 they applied and were not selected, and provided further that the department is authorized to adopt regulations to amend or supplement 38 39 this process for issuing marine and coastal district party and charter boat licenses; 40 8. Temporary authorization. In the event of a temporary emergency, a 41 42 licensee or permittee may provide written authorization for a person to 43 temporarily undertake any licensed activities on the licensee's or 44 permittee's behalf. Such authorization shall not be effective until it has been approved by the department. A copy of such written authori-45 46 zation shall be filed with the department, and the department shall 47 determine what constitutes a temporary emergency and the appropriate 48 maximum duration of a temporary emergency for the purposes of this 49 subdivision. The department is authorized to adopt regulations to establish requirements for this program. 50
