AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring information concerning services for human trafficking victims to be posted in lactation rooms at truck stops

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 1 and 3 of section 390-d of the general busi-2 ness law, as added by chapter 391 of the laws of 2022, is amended to 3 read as follows:

4 1. The operator of any truck stop shall make available in plain view 5 and in a conspicuous place and manner in all sanitary facilities avail-6 able for public use <u>and in any lactation rooms</u>, informational cards 7 and/or signs developed by:

8 (i) the office of temporary and disability assistance in consultation 9 with the New York state interagency task force on human trafficking; or 10 (ii) the United States Department of Homeland Security.

11 3. For purposes of this section, ["truck] the following terms shall 12 have the following meanings:

13 (i) "Truck stop" shall mean a facility that has the capacity to 14 provide fuel or service, or both, to any commercial motor vehicle as 15 defined by subdivision four of section five hundred one-a of the vehicle 16 and traffic law operating in commerce which is located within twenty-17 five hundred feet of a controlled-access highway as defined by section 18 one hundred nine of the vehicle and traffic law which has been functionally classified by the department of transportation as principal 19 arterial - interstate or principal arterial - other freeway/expressway 20 21 on official functional classification maps approved by the federal high-22 way administration pursuant to part 470.105 of title 23 of the code of 23 federal regulations, as amended from time to time.

(ii) "Lactation room" shall mean a hygienic place, other than a rest room, that is intended to be used for the primary purpose of breastfeed ing or expressing breast milk.

27 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 28 manner as section 1 of chapter 391 of the laws of 2022, takes effect.
