AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to allowing retail licensees for on-premises consumption to join in a cooperative agreement for the purchase of alcoholic beverages

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a 2 new section 106-c to read as follows:

§ 106-c. Cooperative agreements by licensees to sell at retail for 4 consumption on the premises. Any two or more retail licensees for 5 on-premises consumption may join in a cooperative agreement to make joint purchases of alcoholic beverages in larger quantities than might otherwise be purchased; provided, however, that all alcoholic beverages purchased pursuant to any such agreement shall be distributed to none other than a licensee who is a party to such agreement.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 10 11 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amend-12 ment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implemen-13 tation of this act on its effective date are authorized and directed to 14 be made and completed on or before such effective date.
