AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to modular construction work

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 5 of title 28 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new article 506 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 506

MODULAR UNITS WITH ELECTRICAL, PLUMBING, AND FIRE SUPPRESSION **ASSEMBLIES**

§ 28-506.1 Definitions. As used in this article:

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- 1. "Modular unit" shall mean component parts assembled at a location other than the construction site which are to be transported to the construction site for installation as part of a manufactured building.
- 2. "Component parts" shall mean any sub-system, sub-assembly, or other system or fabrication designed for use in or as part of a structure, 12 which may include woodwork, cases, cabinets or counters and the fabri-14 cation of electrical, plumbing, heating, cooling, ventilation, fire protection, exhaust duct systems, and mechanical insulation, or other 16 systems affecting health and safety, designed and engineered for installation in the construction, repair, or renovation of a manufactured 18 building.
- 19 3. "Manufactured building" shall mean a structure consisting of one or 20 more transportable modular units built within a manufacturing facility

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or facilities, where such building is designed to be greater than six stories in height.

§ 28-506.2 Off-site electrical, plumbing, and fire suppression work. All electrical, plumbing, and fire suppression work during off-site assembly of a modular unit shall be performed by an applicable licensee pursuant to chapter four of this title with employees under the <u>licensee's supervision.</u>

§ 28-506.3 Records demonstrating compliance. Each licensee performing off-site assemblies pursuant to this article shall maintain records demonstrating compliance of such modular unit pursuant to the provisions of this title with respect to the type of work being performed. Such records shall be maintained for at least six years from the date of the issuance of the final certificate of occupancy for the manufactured building.

§ 28-506.4 Licensee certification. Prior to the transportation of any modular unit to the construction site for installation, each licensee shall submit a signed and sealed certification to the department attesting to the compliance of such modular unit pursuant to the provisions of this code with respect to the type of work being performed. Each modular unit transported to the construction site shall be accompanied with a copy of the applicable certifications required pursuant to this section. Such certifications shall be submitted to the department, in a form and manner as determined by the department, and all inspectors prior to installation of the modular unit and shall be maintained at the jobsite until the completion of the manufactured building.

§ 28-506.5 Owner certification. Prior to the issuance of any work permits associated with the on-site construction of a manufactured building, the owner of such manufactured building shall certify to the department that he or she hired the appropriate licensees pursuant to chapter four of this title to perform all electrical, plumbing, and fire suppression work for such modular unit with employees under the licensees' supervision.

§ 28-506.6 On-site construction. All electrical, plumbing, and fire suppression work necessary for installing or connecting the modular 34 units on the construction site shall be performed by an applicable licensee pursuant to chapter four of this title with employees under the licensee's supervision, pursuant to a work permit covering such installations and connections.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
