AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to re-defining physically helpless

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Subdivision 7 of section 130.00 of the penal law is Section 1.
- 2 amended to read as follows: 7. "Physically helpless" means that a person is unconscious or for any
- 4 other reason is physically unable to communicate [unwillingness] affirmative consent to an act. Such affirmative consent is a knowing, volun-
- tary, and mutual decision among all participants to engage in sexual
- 7 activity. Consent can be given by words or actions, as long as those
- words or actions create clear permission regarding willingness to engage 9 <u>in the sexual activity.</u>
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 10
