AN ACT in relation to placing a moratorium on tax lien sales in a city with a population of one million or more

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a city with a population of one million or more shall place a moratorium on tax lien sales until April 1, 2022 due to the financial hardships 4 placed on property owners as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
