AN ACT to amend the emergency tenant protection act of nineteen seventy-four, in relation to the declaration of housing emergencies for rental housing accommodations located in buildings owned by certain limited-profit housing companies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of section 4 of chapter 576 of the laws of 1974, constituting the emergency tenant protection act of nineteen seventy-3 four, is amended by adding a new subdivision c to read as follows:

c. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph three or five of subdivision a of this section but subject to any other applicable exceptions in such subdivision, rental housing accommodations located in buildings which were owned by a company established under article 2 of the private housing finance law, other than a mutual company, that voluntarily dissolved pursuant to section 35 of such law shall be fully subject to the provisions of this act. The provision of subdivision a of section nine of this act shall not apply to any housing accommodation which became subject to this act pursuant to this subdivision.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to housing 14 companies that dissolve before, on or after such date.
