AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to requiring a certified dietitian or certified nutritionist on-site during hours of operation at a comprehensive care center for eating disorders

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 30.04 of the mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new paragraph 2-a to read as follows:

2-a. The applicant has a certified dietitian or certified nutritionist
as defined in section eight thousand one of the education law on-site
during hours of operation. For purposes of this paragraph, "hours of
operation" shall mean the specific time during which a comprehensive
care center is open to the public for business;

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
