AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to allowances for the costs of diapers  $% \left( 1\right) =\left( 1\right) +\left( 1\right)$ 

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 350 of the social services law is amended by adding a new paragraph (c) to read as follows:
- 3 (c) In accordance with the regulations of the department approved by
  4 the director of the budget, allowances granted under the provisions of
  5 this title may include the costs of diapers for an eligible child, two
  6 years of age or younger. Said allowances shall not exceed eighty
  7 dollars, every three months, per eligible child. For the purposes of
  8 this paragraph, an eligible child shall be any child with a parent,
  9 guardian, or custodian who qualifies for assistance from the federal
- 10 temporary assistance for needy families block grant.
  - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
