AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to declaring the goal of the state of New York to source reduce, reuse, recycle, or compost no less than eighty-five percent of the solid waste generated by the year 2032

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a 2 new section 27-0102 to read as follows:
- 3 § 27-0102. Declaration of policy.
- The legislature hereby declares that it shall be a goal of the state of New York to source reduce, reuse, recycle, or compost no less than eighty-five percent of the solid waste generated by the year two thousand thirty-two, and annually thereafter.
- 8 § 2. Subdivision 1 of section 3-0301 of the environmental conservation 9 law is amended by adding a new paragraph oo to read as follows:
- oo. Advise and cooperate with planning units, as defined in section 27-0107 of this chapter, to achieve the goal of section 27-0102 of this chapter.
- § 3. No later than January 1, 2025, the department of environmental conservation shall submit a report to the governor and the legislature outlining strategies to achieve the state's goal pursuant to section 27-0102 of the environmental conservation law.
- 17 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
