AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to exempting agricultural employers from paying for unemployment benefits for federally ineligible farm labor

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 564 of the labor law, as amended 2 by chapter 105 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:

- 2. Exclusion from coverage. For purposes of this section the term 4 "employment" shall not include services rendered by an individual who is admitted to the United States to perform agricultural labor pursuant to 8 USC 1188 or an individual who is an alien admitted to the United States to perform agricultural labor pursuant to sections 214(c) and 101(a)(15)(H) of the Federal Immigration and Nationality Act and if, at 9 the time such services are rendered, they are excluded from the definition of employment in section 3306(c) of the Federal Unemployment Tax 11 Act.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
