AN ACT in relation to granting on-premises alcohol retailers an extension of one year to renew their expired liquor license without any late fees during the COVID-19 state disaster emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
- 2 if an on-premises alcohol retailer has experienced a renewal date for
- 3 their New York state liquor license between the date a state disaster
- 4 emergency was declared by the governor pursuant to executive order 202
- 5 and April 1, 2021, such retailer shall receive an extension of one year
- 6 from the time such liquor license has expired to renew such license, and
- 7 no late fees shall be charged for such extension.
- 8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
