AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring veterinarians to provide certain information to animal owners regarding the drugs dispensed to an animal

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6715
2 to read as follows:

3 § 6715. Dispensing information to be provided by veterinarians. 1.
4 Each time a veterinarian prescribes, dispenses, or provides a drug to an
5 animal, the veterinarian shall provide to the owner of such animal, or
6 his or her agent, the following information:

7 (a) the name and description of the drug;

8 (b) directions for use, including, if applicable, any actions to be
9 taken in the event of a missed dose;

10 (c) if available, manufacturer instructions for proper storage;

11 (d) any common adverse effects associated with the use of such drug;
12 and

13 (e) if available, manufacturer precautions and relevant warnings.

14 2. The provisions of paragraphs (d) and (e) of subdivision one of this
15 section shall only apply when the manufacturer has made available infor-
16 mation for the specific animal species to which such drug is prescribed,
17 dispensed or provided.

18 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after
19 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amend-
20 ment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implemen-
21 tation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and
22 completed on or before such date.
