AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the declaration of a sign as a public nuisance

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 28-503.1 of the administrative code of the city of 2 New York, as added by local law number 33 of the city of New York for 3 the year 2007, is amended to read as follows:

§ 28-503.1 General. A sign with a surface area greater than 200 square feet (19 m{2}) that is erected, maintained, attached, affixed, painted on, or in any other manner represented on a building or premises in violation of the zoning resolution, this code, the 1968 building code or rules adopted pursuant thereto is hereby declared to be a public nuisance. The commissioner [may] shall, after notice and hearing, order the removal of such illegal sign [or] and its sign structure [or both], if applicable, as hereinafter provided.

12 § 2. The commissioner of buildings shall immediately order the removal 13 of any sign and its sign structure that has previously been deemed ille-14 gal.

15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
