AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to suspending state support for the local enforcement of past-due property taxes until after the end of the COVID-19 state disaster emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 171-w of the tax law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 12 to read as follows:

(12) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary, 4 the commissioner shall extend the date by which any delinquent property 5 owner shall be required to pay his or her past-due property taxes in full in order to receive STAR credits or STAR exemptions, until after the end of the COVID-19 state disaster emergency declared by executive 8 order number two hundred two and any further amendments or modifications 9 thereto, and as may be further extended pursuant to section twenty-eight 10 of the executive law. The department shall notify all delinquent prop-

11 <u>erty owners of such extension.</u>

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
