AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to qualifications for holding certain offices in the village of Northville in Fulton County

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new subdivision 71 to read as follows:

71. In the village of Northville, in the county of Fulton, the provisions of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are required to be exercised, shall not prevent a person from holding the office of treasurer, village clerk and code enforcement officer, provided that such person resides in Fulton county, or in the town of Edinburg in Saratoga county or the town of Benson in Hamilton county; provided, however that any person performing such functions or holding such office in any other village shall be a resident of such village unless otherwise provided by law.

14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
