AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to exempting certain personal protective clothing and equipment from the tax on sales and the compensating use tax

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 1115 of the tax law is amended 1 2 by adding a new paragraph 47 to read as follows:

(47) Personal protective clothing and equipment worn for protection against illness from infectious disease or materials or to help prevent or reduce the spread of infectious disease or illness. Personal protective clothing and equipment shall include, but not be limited to, isolation gowns and coveralls, gloves, facemasks, face shields, goggles, and any other clothing or equipment determined by the commissioner of 9 health to be effective in protecting the wearer against illness from infectious disease or materials or to help prevent or reduce the spread 10 of infectious disease or illness.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the sales tax 13 quarterly period commencing after this act shall have become a law, and 14 shall apply to sales made and uses occurring on and after such date in 15 accordance with applicable transitional provisions of sections 1106 and 16 1217 of the tax law.
