AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to waiving the requirement of establishing paternity or a child support order for certain applicants or recipients of aid to dependent children

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## 1 Section 1. Section 349-b of the social services law is amended by

2 adding a new subdivision 3 to read as follows:
3 <u>3. When the applicant or recipient has established good cause to</u>
4 refuse to cooperate, the social services district shall take no action

5 to establish paternity or a child support order. 6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
