AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to designating additional participating agencies for purposes of agency assisted voter registration

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The opening paragraph of section 5-211 of the election law,  
2 as separately amended by chapters 587 and 672 of the laws of 2019, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Each agency designated as a participating agency under the provisions  
5 of this section shall implement and administer a program of distribution  
6 of voter registration forms pursuant to the provisions of this section.  
7 The following offices which provide public assistance and/or provide  
8 state funded programs primarily engaged in providing services to persons  
9 with disabilities are hereby designated as voter registration agencies:  
10 designated as the state agencies which provide public assistance are the  
11 office of children and family services, the office of temporary and  
12 disability assistance and the department of health. Also designated as  
13 public assistance agencies are all agencies of local government that  
14 provide such assistance. Designated as state agencies that provide  
15 programs primarily engaged in providing services to people with disabili-  
16 ties are the department of labor, office for the aging, division of  
17 veterans' services, office of mental health, office of vocational and  
18 educational services for individuals with disabilities, commission on  
19 quality of care for the mentally disabled, office for people with devel-  
20 opmental disabilities, commission for the blind, office of alcoholism  
21 and substance abuse services, the office of the advocate for the disa-  
22 bled and all offices which administer programs established or funded by  
23 such agencies. Additional participating agencies designated as voter

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1 registration offices are the department of state and the district  
2 offices of the workers' compensation board. Such agencies shall be  
3 required to offer voter registration forms to persons upon initial  
4 application for services, renewal or recertification for services and  
5 upon change of address relating to such services. Such agencies shall  
6 also be responsible for providing assistance to applicants in completing  
7 voter registration forms, receiving and transmitting the completed  
8 application form from all applicants who wish to have such form trans-  
9 mitted to the appropriate board of elections. The state board of  
10 elections shall, together with representatives of the United States  
11 department of defense, develop and implement procedures for including  
12 recruitment offices of the armed forces of the United States as voter  
13 registration offices when such offices are so designated by federal law.  
14 The state board of elections shall also make request of the United  
15 States Citizenship and Immigration Services to include applications for  
16 registration by mail with any materials which are given to new citizens.  
17 Also designated as participating agencies are all public libraries,  
18 which shall be required to offer voter registration forms to persons  
19 eighteen years of age or older upon initial application for a library  
20 card. Also designated as participating agencies are all local housing  
21 authorities, which shall be required to offer voter registration forms  
22 to persons upon initial application for services or recertification for  
23 services. Also designated as participating agencies are all public high  
24 schools, which shall be required to offer voter registration forms to  
25 all seniors upon their graduation.

26 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after  
27 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amend-  
28 ment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implemen-  
29 tation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and  
30 completed on or before such effective date.
