AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to the licensure of certain child day care programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 390 of the social services law, as 2 added by chapter 750 of the laws of 1990, is amended to read as follows: 5. Child day care providers required to have a license from the 4 department or to be registered with the department pursuant to this section shall not be exempt from such requirement through registration with another state agency, or certification, registration, or licensure by any local governmental agency or any authorized agency; provided, however, that any public school district or private school, regulated by 9 the department of education, which operates a child day care program in 10 a building owned and operated by such public school district or private 11 school, shall be exempt from the provisions of this section. 12

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
