AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to authorizing certain community composting operations in a city with a population of one million or more to use parklands without violating alienation laws or restrictions

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a 2 new section 27-0111 to read as follows:

§ 27-0111. Compost facilities in cities with a population of one million or more.

In cities with a population of one million or more, community scale 6 compost operations requiring registration with, but not a permit from, 7 the department shall be permitted to operate in parklands within such 8 cities and shall not be in violation of any laws or restrictions relating to the alienation of such parklands.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
