AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to persons responsible for the disposition of the remains of a decedent

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The opening paragraph of paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of 2 section 4201 of the public health law, as amended by chapter 401 of the 3 laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:

The following persons in descending priority shall have the right to control the disposition of the remains of such decedent; provided that if there are more than two members of a class listed in subparagraph (iii), (v), or (vii) of this paragraph entitled to control the disposition of remains of a decedent, the disposition shall be determined by a majority of the members of the class who are reasonably available:

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
