AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to requiring condominium by-laws to allow for the conduct of unit owner meetings via electronic means

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 339-v of the real property law, as added by chapter 82 of the laws of 1964, is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (b) [Method] Methods of calling meetings of the unit owners; what 5 percentage of the unit owners, if other than a majority, shall constitute a quorum; and what percentage shall, consistent with the provisions of this act, be necessary to adopt decisions binding on all unit owners. 8 Meetings of unit owners may be held at such place, within or without this state, as may be fixed by or under the by-laws, or if not so fixed, as determined by the board of managers. If, pursuant to this paragraph or the by-laws, the board of managers is authorized to determine the place of a meeting of unit owners, the board of managers may, in its sole discretion, determine that the meeting be held solely by means of electronic communication, the platform/service of which shall be the place of the meeting for purposes of this article.
- 16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
