AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to authorizing the board of managers of a condominium to allow unit owner meetings to be conducted via electronic means

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 339-v of the real  
2 property law, as added by chapter 82 of the laws of 1964, is amended to  
3 read as follows:

4 (b) [~~Method~~] Methods of calling meetings of the unit owners; what  
5 percentage of the unit owners, if other than a majority, shall consti-  
6 tute a quorum; and what percentage shall, consistent with the provisions  
7 of this [~~act~~] section, be necessary to adopt decisions binding on all  
8 unit owners. Meetings of unit owners may be held at such physical place  
9 as may be fixed by or under the by-laws, or if not so fixed, as deter-  
10 mined by the board of managers. Provided, however, that the board of  
11 managers may, in its sole discretion, determine that the meeting be held  
12 solely or partially by means of electronic communication, the  
13 platform/service of which shall be the place of the meeting for  
14 purposes of this article. Nothing contained in this paragraph shall  
15 prohibit a board of managers from holding a meeting at a physical place  
16 and allowing unit owners the option of attending such meeting either at  
17 such physical place or by means of electronic communication.

18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
