AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting cosmetic products and personal care products that contain mercury

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The section heading of section 37-0117 of the environmental 2 conservation law, as amended by chapter 44 of the laws of 2020, is amended and a new subdivision 8 is added to read as follows:

Prohibition of cosmetic products and personal care products containing 5 1,4-dioxane or mercury.

8. No person shall sell or offer for sale any cosmetic product or personal care product containing mercury. For the purposes of this subdivision "mercury" shall mean elemental mercury Hq, mercuric iodide, 9 mercury oxide, mercurous chloride, ethyl mercury, phenyl mercuric 10 salts, ammoniated mercury, amide chloride of mercury, mercury sulfide or 11 <u>cinnabaris</u>, or mercury iodide.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect June 1, 2023.
