AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the crime of falsifying COVID-19 vaccination records

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 156.25 of the penal law, as added by a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the penal law relating to making the falsification of COVID-19 vaccination records a crime, as 4 proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 4516-C and A. 7536-B, is amended to read as follows:
- 5. he intentionally <u>enters or</u> alters in any manner or destroys comput-7 er material indicating that a person did or did not receive a vaccina-8 tion against COVID-19.
- 9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 10 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the penal law relating 11 to making the falsification of COVID-19 vaccination records a crime, as 12 proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 4516-C and A. 7536-B, takes 13 effect.
