AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to a report by the division for small business

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 170-c of the executive law, as 2 added by a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the executive law relat-3 ing to a report by the division for small business, as proposed in 4 legislative bills numbers S. 6642-A and A. 7500, is amended to read as 5 follows:

б 4. Every state agency shall provide to the division for small busi-7 ness, created pursuant to section one hundred thirty-two of the economic development law, the following information covering the previous calen-8 dar year, annually by [March] July first following the effective date of 9 this subdivision, and every [March] July first thereafter: (a) how many 10 11 cure periods or other opportunities for ameliorative action were 12 [offered] afforded pursuant to subdivision one of this section and how many small businesses made use of such options, (b) how many cure peri-13 14 ods and other opportunities for ameliorative action were successfully 15 completed and resulted in the avoidance of a penalty, (c) what, if any, 16 guidance, information, and assistance with compliance was provided to 17 small businesses **issued** pursuant to subdivision one of this section, and 18 the [average length] range of time granted by the state agency to (d) correct first time violations and the type of violations that were amel-19 **iorated**. The division for small business shall by [May] October first following the effective date of this subdivision, and every [May] Octo-20 21 22 **ber** first thereafter, prepare a report compiling this information, by 23 agency, and shall post this report on its website and shall provide a 24 copy of such report to the governor, the speaker of the assembly and the temporary president of the senate. 25

26 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 27 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the executive law 28 relating to a report by the division for small business, as proposed in 29 legislative bills numbers S. 6642-A and A. 7500, takes effect.
