AN ACT to amend a chapter of the laws of 2021 establishing the New York state rural ambulance services task force, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 3503-C and A. 1561-C, in relation to modifying the membership of the New York state rural ambulance services task force and extending the report submission date

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subparagraphs (vi) and (vii) of paragraph (a) of subdivi-2 sion 2 and subdivision 4 of section 1 of a chapter of the laws of 2021 3 establishing the New York state rural ambulance services task force, as 4 proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 3503-C and A. 1561-C, are 5 amended and a new subparagraph (viii) is added to paragraph (a) of 6 subdivision 2 to read as follows:

7 (vi) two members appointed by the office of fire prevention and 8 control; [and]

9 (vii) two members appointed by the bureau of emergency medical 10 services[-]; and

11 (viii) two members appointed by the commissioner of labor.

12 4. Within [**twelve**] <u>eighteen</u> months of the effective date of this act, 13 the department of health shall submit a report detailing the findings of 14 the study to the governor, the temporary president of the senate, and 15 the speaker of the assembly.

16 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 17 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2021 establishing the New York state 18 rural ambulance services task force, as proposed in legislative bills 19 numbers S. 3503-C and A. 1561-C, takes effect.
