AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the sale of over-the-counter drugs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The article heading of article 38-A of the general business law, as added by chapter 697 of the laws of 1986, is amended to read as follows:

## AND LABEL OBSTRUCTED OVER-THE-COUNTER DRUGS

- § 2. Subdivision 2 of section 820 of the general business law, as added by chapter 697 of the laws of 1986, is amended to read as follows: 2. to knowingly alter, mutilate, destroy, obliterate or remove by means of a price sticker or otherwise the whole or any part of [the expiration date displayed on ] the label [or packaging], including where 11 applicable the expiration date displayed thereon, of any over-the-coun-12 ter drug or cosmetic. For purposes of this subdivision, the term "label" 13 shall mean the label required by the statutes applicable to and regu-14 lations issued by the federal food and drug administration.
  - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
