Introduced by M. of A. BURDICK -- read once and referred to the Committee on People with Disabilities

AN ACT in relation to directing the New York State Office for People With Developmental Disabilities, in conjunction with New York State Industries for the Disabled, to establish a voluntary training and certification program for employers that have taken the EmployAbility Pledge; and making an appropriation therefor

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. a. The New York State Office for People With Developmental 1 2 Disabilities (OPWDD), in conjunction with New York State Industries for 3 the Disabled (NYSID), shall establish a voluntary training and certif-4 ication program for employers that have taken the EmployAbility Pledge and that support an inclusive workplace. The program shall promote tech-5 niques and strategies employers can implement to increase diversity in 6 7 the employer's workforce through the hiring of individuals with disabil-8 ities and to increase diversity in the selection of the employer's 9 supply chains by working with companies that employ individuals with 10 disabilities.

b. OPWDD will contract with NYSID to develop the content of the program and to manage the program. In developing the content of the program, NYSID shall work with vendors who provide services to or employee individuals with disabilities including, but not limited to multimedia company Our Ability. As part of the program, NYSID will develop a series of online/virtual training programs for employers for key components related to training employers on topics including:

18 (i) sensitivity training on disability disclosure;

19 (ii) providing reasonable accommodations to employees with disabili-20 ties;

21 (iii) tax credits for employers who employee individuals with disabil-22 ities;

23 (iv) website accessibility;

24 (v) interviewing individuals with disabilities and appropriate job 25 opening advertisements;

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(vi) workplace inclusion of individuals with disabilities;

2 (vii) supply chain diversity;

3 (viii) the role of job coaches in assisting employers; and

4 (ix) corporate partnership training for employers for purposes of 5 qualifying for preferred source procurement status.

6 c. NYSID may institute a reasonable fee for the training in an amount 7 to be agreed upon by NYSID and OPWDD.

8 § 2. The sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is here-9 by appropriated to the New York State Office for People With Develop-10 mental Disabilities out of any moneys in the state treasury in the 11 general fund to the credit of the state purposes account, not otherwise 12 appropriated, and made immediately available, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act. Such moneys shall be payable on the 13 audit and warrant of the comptroller on vouchers certified or approved 14 15 by the head of the New York State Office for People With Developmental 16 Disabilities in the manner prescribed by law.

17 § 3. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 18 have become a law.
