AN ACT to amend the banking law, in relation to requiring licensed cashers of checks to file suspicious activity reports

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 8 herewith. Such rules, regulations, rulings, demands and findings shall
- 9 include, but not be limited to, requiring licensed cashers of checks to
- 10 file suspicious activity reports.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
