AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Trooper Martin J. Kerins Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-n to
2 read as follows:

3 § 344-n. Portion of state highway system to be designated as the
4 "Trooper Martin J. Kerins Memorial Bridge". The bridge on county route
5 three, exits number thirty-five on the east and westbound southern state
6 parkway in the town of Babylon, county of Suffolk shall be designated
7 and known as the "Trooper Martin J. Kerins Memorial Bridge".

8 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-
9 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system
10 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid
11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-
12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of
13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be
14 changed as a result of this act.

15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
