AN ACT to amend the general construction law, in relation to the definition of legislation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The general construction law is amended by adding a new 2 section 27-a to read as follows:

§ 27-a. Legislation. The term "legislation" shall refer to any proposed language prepared in accordance with New York state law, the rules of the assembly and the rules of the senate by the New York state legislative bill drafting commission for introduction and passage by the New York state legislature, whether such language be considered consolidated or unconsolidated for the purposes of enactment. Any such language shall be prepared in a clear and concise manner.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
