AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to reducing the signature  
requirement for petitions for candidates for the school board of the  
city of Buffalo

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-  
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 6-136 of the election law is  
2 amended by adding a new paragraph (f-1) to read as follows:

3 (f-1) For the school board of the city of Buffalo, county of Erie, two  
4 hundred signatures for district seats and four hundred signatures for at  
5 large seats;

6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided however that the  
7 amendments to subdivision 2 of section 6-136 of the election law made by  
8 section one of this act shall survive the expiration and reversion of  
9 such subdivision as provided in section 4 of chapter 22 of the laws of  
10 2021, as amended.
