AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to authorizing the public service commission to require water-works corporations to provide certain residents with non-billing related information

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 89-c of the public service law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 17 to read as follows:
- 17. The commission shall have power to require each water-works corpotration to establish a process for residents of any cooperative, condominium or multi-family dwelling with five or more residential units,
 which uses a master meter to distribute water to such residents, to
- 7 obtain non-billing related information regarding the delivery of water
- 8 <u>including</u> <u>but not limited to service updates, water quality notices and</u>
 9 <u>other information deemed essential to water consumers.</u>
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
