AN ACT to amend chapter 598 of the laws of 1938 relating to incorporating the volunteer and exempt firemen's benevolent association of Briarcliff Manor, New York, and providing for its powers and duties, in relation to precept of payment of foreign fire insurance companies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 1 and section 8 of chapter 598 of
2 the laws of 1938 relating to incorporating the volunteer and exempt
3 firemen's benevolent association of Briarcliff Manor, New York, and
4 providing for its powers and duties, as amended by a chapter of the laws
5 of 2020 amending chapter 598 of the laws of 1938 relating to changing
6 the form of the benevolent from a corporation to an unincorporated asso-
7 ciation, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S.8531 and A.10313,
8 are amended to read as follows:
9 2. All persons who now are or have been, or who hereafter shall be
10 volunteer members of the village of Briarcliff Manor fire department, or
11 of any fire engine, hook and ladder, patrol, emergency rescue squad or
12 hose company in the village of Briarcliff Manor or in any fire district
13 outside of but contiguous to such fire district which contracts with the
14 village of Briarcliff Manor for fire protection pursuant to the law in
15 such case made and provided, and all persons in any such fire district
16 and in such village who are entitled to the general exemptions of fire-
17 fighters therein as provided in section two hundred-a of the general
18 municipal law, and two hundred nine of the village law, [~~and—successor~~
19 ~~statutes~~] respectively, and acts amendatory thereof or supplemental
20 thereto; or of any other applicable law, shall be eligible to membership
21 therein.

EXPLANATION--Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets
[-] is old law to be omitted.

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1 § 8. Precept of payment of foreign fire insurance companies. The
2 association shall collect and there shall be paid to it all tax imposed
3 by section [~~one hundred thirty-three~~] nine thousand one hundred four of
4 the insurance law[, ~~and successor statutes,~~] upon premiums on policies
5 of insurance covering property situated within the village of Briarcliff
6 Manor, Westchester county, New York, or within any duly organized terri-
7 tory in which the fire department of said fire district is obligated to
8 render fire protection, except that the association shall remit such
9 percentage of all taxes so collected or paid to it, to the treasurer of
10 the firemen's association of the state of New York, as may be required
11 by the insurance law. The officer of the association designated by its
12 by-laws to collect and receive the aforesaid tax shall have all the
13 powers and be subject to all the provisions of section [~~one hundred~~
14 ~~thirty-three~~] nine thousand one hundred four of the insurance law [~~and~~
15 ~~successor statutes~~], relating to the treasurer of fire departments. The
16 association shall also be entitled to receive a share of the tax imposed
17 by section [~~one hundred forty-nine-a~~] nine thousand one hundred five of
18 the insurance law, [~~and successor statutes,~~] based upon the business
19 written in the territory with respect to which it is entitled to collect
20 and receive the tax under section [~~one hundred thirty-three~~] nine thou-
21 sand one hundred four of the insurance law [~~and successor statutes~~]. The
22 association shall also be entitled to receive and collect all taxes
23 heretofore due and owing and unpaid at the time of the creation of the
24 association.

25 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same
26 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2020 amending chapter 598 of the laws
27 of 1938 relating to changing the form of the benevolent from a corpo-
28 ration to an unincorporated association, as proposed in legislative
29 bills numbers S.8531 and A.10313, takes effect.
