AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of unlawful storage of a firearm leading to use in the commission of a crime

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 265.46 to 2 read as follows:

3 <u>§ 265.46 Unlawful storage of a firearm leading to use in the commission</u>
4 <u>of a crime.</u>

A person is quilty of unlawful storage of a firearm leading to use in the commission of a crime when a person fails to safely store a rifle, shotgun or firearm as required pursuant to section 265.45 of this article, and such rifle, shotgun or firearm is used in the commission of a crime by another individual which reasonably would have been prevented if such rifle, shotgun or firearm was stored in accordance with section 265.45 of this article.

12 <u>Unlawful storage of a firearm leading to use in the commission of a</u>

13 <u>crime is a class E felony.</u>
14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
