AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to extradition of abortion providers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The criminal procedure law is amended by adding a new 2 section 570.17 to read as follows:
- 3 § 570.17 Extradition of abortion providers.
- No demand for the extradition of a person charged with providing an abortion shall be recognized by the governor unless the executive authority of the demanding state shall allege in writing that the accused was present in the demanding state at the time of the commission of the alleged offense, and that thereafter he, she or they fled from that state.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
