AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to removing restrictions on crossbow size and draw weight when used for hunting

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph 9 of paragraph b of subdivision 4 of section 11-0901 of the environmental conservation law, as added by section 6 of part EE of chapter 55 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as 3 4 follows:

- (9) with a crossbow unless [such crossbow shall consist of a bow and string, either compound or recurve, that launches a minimum fourteen inch bolt, not including point, mounted upon a stock with a trigger that holds the string and limbs under tension until released. The trigger unit of such crossbow [must have] has a working safety. [The minimum limb width of such crossbow shall be seventeen inches, have a minimum peak draw weight of one hundred pounds and a maximum peak draw weight of 12 two hundred pounds. The minimum overall length of such crossbow from 13 buttstock to front of limbs shall be twenty four inches.
- 14 § 2. Subparagraph 9 of paragraph c of subdivision 4 of section 11-0901 15 of the environmental conservation law, as added by section 7 of part EE 16 of chapter 55 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:
- (9) with a crossbow unless [such crossbow shall consist of a bow and string, either compound or recurve, that launches a minimum fourteen inch bolt, not including point, mounted upon a stock with a trigger that holds the string and limbs under tension until released. The trigger unit of such crossbow [must have] has a working safety. [The minimum 22 limb width of such crossbow shall be seventeen inches, have a minimum 23 peak draw weight of one hundred pounds and a maximum peak draw weight of two hundred pounds. The minimum overall length of such crossbow from 25 buttstock to front of limbs shall be twenty-four inches.
  - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
