AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to establishing a commission on hosting the two thousand thirty-four olympic games

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new
2 section 2611-a to read as follows:

3 § 2611-a. Commission on hosting the two thousand thirty-four olympic
4 games. 1. When used in this section the following terms shall have the
5 following meanings:

6 (a) "commission" shall mean the commission established under this
7 section.

8 (b) "olympics" shall mean the two thousand thirty-four olympic games.

9 2. There is hereby established within the New York state olympic
10 regional development authority a commission on hosting the two thousand
11 thirty-four olympic games which shall consist of nine members and shall
12 have and exercise the powers and the duties set forth in this section.

13 3. The commission shall consist of nine members of whom one shall be
14 appointed by the governor, one each by the speaker of the assembly, the
15 temporary president of the senate, the minority leader of the senate,
16 and the minority leader of the assembly, and four by the authority. Any
17 vacancy on such commission shall be filled in the same manner as the
18 original appointment was made. Members of the commission shall be resi-
19 dents of the state.

20 4. Members of the commission shall designate a chair from the member-
21 ship thereof for a term of one year. Any member of the commission may
22 call a meeting. Seven members shall constitute a quorum. The commission
23 may meet and hold public and/or private hearings within or without the
24 state, and shall have all the powers of a legislative committee pursuant
25 to the legislative law.

26 5. The members of the authority shall not receive a salary or other
27 compensation for their services as members of the commission but each
28 member shall be allowed reimbursement for the necessary and actual

1 expenses which he or she shall incur in the performance of his or her
2 duties under this section.

3 6. The commission shall:

4 (a) determine the feasibility for Lake Placid to host the olympics
5 with a partner municipality;

6 (b) investigate which municipalities could partner with Lake Placid
7 for hosting the olympics;

8 (c) identify the best partner municipality for Lake Placid; and

9 (d) before February first, two thousand twenty-three, report to the
10 governor and the legislature regarding its findings and recommendations.

11 7. The commission may employ and at pleasure remove such personnel as
12 it may deem necessary for the performance of its functions and fix their
13 compensation within the amounts made available by appropriation thereof,
14 if any, or by donation, if any.

15 8. For the accomplishment of its purposes, the commission shall be
16 authorized and empowered to undertake any studies, inquiries, surveys or
17 analyses it may deem relevant through its own personnel or in cooper-
18 ation with or by agreement with any other public or private agency.

19 9. The commission may request and shall receive from any agency in the
20 state and from any subdivision, department, board, bureau, commission,
21 office, agency or other instrumentality of the state or of any political
22 subdivision thereof such facilities, assistance and data as it deems
23 necessary or desirable for the proper execution of its powers and duties
24 and to effectuate the purposes set forth in this section.

25 10. The commission is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into
26 any agreements and to do and perform any acts that may be necessary,
27 desirable or proper to carry out the purposes and objectives of this
28 section.

29 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
