AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the placement of school crossing guards $\,$

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 14-118 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding two new subdivisions d and e to read as follows:
- d. The commissioner shall require at least one school crossing guard to be on each and every corner of every city block that contains a public or private school with students enrolled in any grades between kindergarten through eight during arrival and dismissal times as set forth by the school.
- 9 <u>e. Any street with four or more traffic lanes that borders a block</u>
 10 <u>with a public or private school with students enrolled in any grades</u>
 11 <u>between kindergarten through eight shall require an additional school</u>
 12 <u>crossing guard and such crossing guards shall be placed on the opposite</u>
 13 <u>corners of such street respectively.</u>
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
