AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to allowing valid certificates of marriage from foreign governments and religious institutions as acceptable documentation to change a name on the driver's license or non-driver identification card

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:

- 1-a. In addition to any other documentation acceptable to the commis-4 sioner for the purposes of changing a person's name on a driver's 5 license pursuant to subdivision one of this section, the commissioner 6 may accept a valid certificate of marriage from the government of a foreign country or from a bona fide religious institution that issues certificates of marriage in a foreign country.
- § 2. Section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a 9 10 new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:
- 3-a. In addition to any other documentation acceptable to the commissioner for the purposes of changing a person's name on a learner's 12 permit pursuant to subdivisions two and three of this section, the 13 14 commissioner may accept a valid certificate of marriage from the govern-15 ment of a foreign country or from a bona fide religious institution that 16 <u>issues certificates of marriage in a foreign country.</u>
- § 3. Section 490 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a 17 18 new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
- 19 2-a. In addition to any other documentation acceptable to the commis-20 sioner for purposes of changing a person's name on an identification

§ 4. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such date.
