AN ACT to amend the general obligations law, in relation to granting immunity from liability for personal injury, death or property damage incurred by a victim of a crime while seeking assistance upon the premises of a business entity or not-for-profit corporation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 9-103 of the general obligations law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

2-a. an owner, lessee or occupant of a premises, which is operated as a business entity or not-for-profit corporation, who provides assistance to a victim of a crime by allowing such victim to remain upon such premises for the purpose of summoning a police officer and/or emergency 7 medical personnel, shall assume no responsibility for or incur liability 8 for any personal injury, death or property damage sustained by the crime victim while upon such premises in the course of seeking assistance, 9 10 unless it is established that such injury or death was caused by gross 11 negligence on the part of such business entity or not-for-profit corpo-12 ration.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
