AN ACT to amend chapter 598 of the laws of 1938 relating to incorporating the volunteer and exempt firemen's benevolent association of Briarcliff Manor, New York, and providing for its powers and duties, in relation to precept of payment of foreign fire insurance companies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 1 and section 8 of chapter 598 of 2 the laws of 1938 relating to incorporating the volunteer and exempt firemen's benevolent association of Briarcliff Manor, New York, and providing for its powers and duties, as amended by a chapter of the laws of 2020 amending chapter 598 of the laws of 1938 relating to changing the form of the benevolent from a corporation to an unincorporated association, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S.8531 and A.10313, are amended to read as follows:

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- 2. All persons who now are or have been, or who hereafter shall be 10 volunteer members of the village of Briarcliff Manor fire department, or of any fire engine, hook and ladder, patrol, emergency rescue squad or 12 hose company in the village of Briarcliff Manor or in any fire district outside of but contiguous to such fire district which contracts with the village of Briarcliff Manor for fire protection pursuant to the law in such case made and provided, and all persons in any such fire district 15 and in such village who are entitled to the general exemptions of firefighters therein as provided in section two hundred-a of the general 18 municipal law, and two hundred nine of the village law, [and successor 19 **statutes**] respectively, and acts amendatory thereof or supplemental 20 thereto; or of any other applicable law, shall be eligible to membership 21 therein.
- 22 § 8. Precept of payment of foreign fire insurance companies. 23 association shall collect and there shall be paid to it all tax imposed

EXPLANATION--Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [-] is old law to be omitted.

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1 by section [ene hundred thirty-three] nine thousand one hundred four of the insurance law[, and successor statutes,] upon premiums on policies 3 of insurance covering property situated within the village of Briarcliff 4 Manor, Westchester county, New York, or within any duly organized territory in which the fire department of said fire district is obligated to render fire protection, except that the association shall remit such 7 percentage of all taxes so collected or paid to it, to the treasurer of the firemen's association of the state of New York, as may be required 8 9 by the insurance law. The officer of the association designated by its 10 by-laws to collect and receive the aforesaid tax shall have all the 11 powers and be subject to all the provisions of section [ene hundred thirty three nine thousand one hundred four of the insurance law [and 12 13 successor statutes], relating to the treasurer of fire departments. The 14 association shall also be entitled to receive a share of the tax imposed 15 by section [one hundred forty-nine-a] nine thousand one hundred five of the insurance law, [and successor statutes,] based upon the business 17 written in the territory with respect to which it is entitled to collect and receive the tax under section [one hundred thirty-three] nine thou-18 sand one hundred four of the insurance law [and successor statutes]. The 19 20 association shall also be entitled to receive and collect all taxes 21 heretofore due and owing and unpaid at the time of the creation of the 22 association.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 24 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2020 amending chapter 598 of the laws 25 of 1938 relating to changing the form of the benevolent from a corpo-26 ration to an unincorporated association, as proposed in legislative 27 bills numbers S.8531 and A.10313, takes effect.
